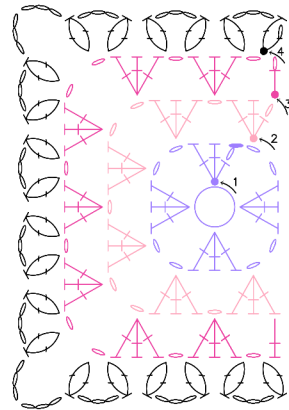


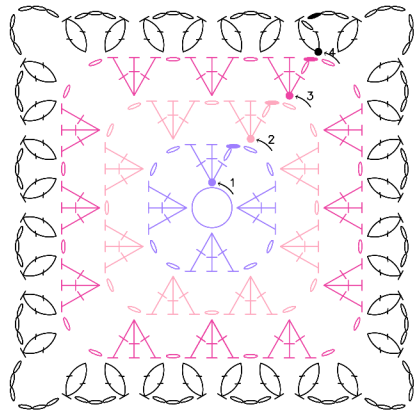
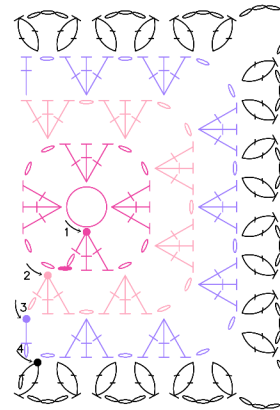
TOTAL NUMBERS OF

Stitch Symbols Abbreviation

●	slip stitch (slst) - new row starting point	∇	3 double crochet (3dc) cluster
—	invisible seam - end of the row	∅	2 double crochet together (2dc2tog)
o	chain (ch)	⊞	ch-3 picot
+	single crochet (sc)	—	not a stitch, red line showing where the two stitches of squares to be join together (joint as you go at last row of the square)
T	half double crochet (hdc)		
‡	double crochet (dc)		

- Notes / Tips :**
1. Starting every row at first (3dc) corner.
 2. 1st row of dc replaced with hdc, ch1 instead of chain 2 for nicer finishes.
 3. Finished the last chain of the row with invisible join/seam method.
 4. There is no rules to start with which block first. But if you are more discipline or to avoid confusing, start from the bottom left in round and working upward.
