



Stitch Symbols Abbreviation

| ● | slip stitch (slst) - new row starting point | ⊕ | 3 double crochet cluster  |
| — | invisible seam - end of the row             | ⊙ | ch-3 picot  |
| ○ | chain (ch)                                  | ⊕ | ch-5 picot  |
| + | single crochet (sc)                         | + | red cross showing to single crochet instead of chain 1 when we working on "joint as you go" at last row of the square |
| ⊥ | half double crochet (hdc)                   |   |   |
| ⊥ | double crochet (dc)                         |   |   |

Notes / Tips :

- 1st row of dc replaced with hdc, ch1 instead of chain 2 for nicer finishes.
- Finished the last chain of the row with invisible join/seam method.
- 3rd row of the square will be "joint as you go".
- There is no rules to start with which block first. But if you are more disciplines start with the bottom left in round and working upward.
